

ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING COUNCIL MEMBERS  
TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Grove is a small rural community with few vendors, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and essential as a matter of public necessity, public welfare, the public interest and convenience for the City of Oak Grove to conduct as much business within the City as possible and to do so requires that City Council members for the City of Oak Grove be permitted to conduct business with the City;

THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oak Grove does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE

That pursuant to the provisions of A. C. A. § 14-42-107(b)(1), City Council members for the City of Oak Grove are hereby authorized to conduct business with the City of Oak Grove.

SECTION TWO

The duly authorized purchasing officers for the City of Oak Grove are hereby authorized to purchase supplies, equipment or services on behalf of the City from those City Council members who are also vendors within the City of Oak Grove for amounts up to and including the sum of One Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month per council member.

SECTION THREE

In the event that any single purchase of supplies, equipment or services from a City Council member would exceed the sum of Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$250.00), at least one documented

competitive bid shall be obtained for said purchase of supplies, equipment or services and the City Council shall purchase from the lowest bid.

SECTION FOUR

The duly authorized disbursing officers for the City of Oak Grove are hereby authorized and directed to pay the invoices for the purchase of supplies, equipment and services on behalf of the City of Oak Grove from those City Council members who are also vendors within the City of Oak Grove for purchases totaling up to and including One Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month per council member.

SECTION FIVE

The City Council of the City of Oak Grove, Arkansas, has found it to be essential to the health, safety and welfare of the City that Ordinance No. 28 take force and effect without delay. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and Ordinance No. 28 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
