

# ORDINANCE # 73-2008

TOWN OF Oak Grove, ARKANSAS

## PROHIBITING LOITERING

To be enacted by the Town of Oak Grove, Arkansas

Section 1: No person or persons shall be allowed to loiter in any public place or private place where they do not have consent of owner, renter, or individual responsible for the property.

Section 2: This shall apply in a motor vehicle or on foot.

Definition: Loitering shall be defined as congregating with no purpose.

Section 3: A person or persons violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 upon prosecution.

Section 4: Emergency Clause: It is hereby determined and declared by the Town Council that not having a no loitering ordinance would be detrimental to the peace and safety of the residents and inhabitants of the Town of Oak Grove and the immediate enactment of the forgoing provisions will prevent the condition from arising. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace and safety, shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of it's adoption.
