ORDINANCE #86-2011

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE KEEPING OF SWINE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Oak Grove, Arkansas, Town Council to provide for and protect the health and safety of the citizens of Oak Grove; to promote residential harmony and to ensure the well-being of properly maintained swine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Oak Grove, Arkansas that swine standard of enclosures be added as follows:

Section one. Number of swine. It shall be unlawful to keep more than two (2) swine.

Section two. Enclosures. No swine shall be allowed to run at large. All swine shall be contained within the enclosed area on the property. Enclosed means in a fenced area, buildings, pens and pastures. Enclosures are to be kept in the rear yard and not located in the front yard. Every enclosure wherein the swine are kept shall be kept in good repair, clean, free of odors and waste substances.

Section three. Area size. No swine in a area of less than one acre per each swine.

<u>Section four.</u> Being aware of the necessity for an ordinance to establish a plan for regulating the keeping of swine within the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
