

Minutes of Meeting
May 23, 1966

A group of 58 adults and several children met at the Oak Grove Schoolhouse Monday night, May 23, 1966, to determine the disposition to be made of the school building and land, since there will no longer be school at Oak Grove.

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Alfred Atchley, acting as Chairman. The first order of business to come before the meeting was to choose a name for the building and land. Motion was made by Clete Callen and seconded by Earl Dean Allen that it be called the Oak Grove Community Center. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on how many board members should be elected to serve. Motion was made by L. O. Tisdale and seconded by George Humbard that there be a president, vice-president, five board members and secretary. Motion carried.

Geneva Waterman nominated Alfred Atchley for president. Nomination seconded by Pat Davis. George Humbard nominated Wayne Plumlee. Nomination seconded by Sherman Garner. Motion was made by Geneva Waterman and seconded by Inez Atchley that nominations cease.

Motion carried. Alfred Atchley received majority of votes.

Motion was made by Ruth Davis and seconded by George Humbard that to be eligible to vote one must be head of family or be of voting age. Motion carried.
