

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
September 22, 1987

The Oak Grove Town Council met at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 22, 1987, to hold a public meeting to have the community voice their opinions on going to court to uphold Ordinance # 14, which prohibits the raising of swine or poultry inside the Town Limits of the Town of Oak Grove.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan. All council members were in attendance.

The Mayor opened the meeting by explaining the events of the past year to make the community aware of the problem the Town Council has. Then the Mayor opened the floor to the public for comments.

Various members voiced their opinions in opposition to having commercial growing houses inside the Town Limits.

A ballot was handed out to allow residents to vote by secret ballot to decide whether the Town Council should repeal Ordinance # 14 or should hire a lawyer to fight the court action brought by Ronnie White.

The vote was

- 6 votes to repeal the ordinance
- 1 vote blank
- 3 votes "no with limitations"
- 101 votes to fight court action
