

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DATE: April 3, 1990

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The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on April 3, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. in the town hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called -Alderman Aaron Curtis, Alderman Hugh Davis, Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Gary High, Alderman Larry Plumlee, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen, and Recorder Delma Allen. Present 8. Absent 0.

The minutes for the March 6, 1990, meeting were read and there being -no - corrections or alterations, Alderman --High- moved to approve the minutes as read and Alderman --Curtis -- seconded. All members voted in the affirmative.

The next order of business is the presentation of the monthly bills: STANDING BILLS-- Allied Telephone, Carroll Electric Cooperative, Maintenance on fire trucks \$40.00, Maintenance on community grounds and ball park \$32.70 for repairs and \$35.00 for gravel, Empire Gas Company of Blue Eye, Mo. NEW BILLS-- Walker Sales \$68.47, R & R Gravel \$37.85, Tanner Hardware \$30.34, Oak Grove Garage \$387.03, Schell Drilling \$5.00, by Randy Sooter, Davis Service \$55.00, Fire truck insurance on '71 International -  
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----- Changed from Dodge Firetruck-----  
----- Motion to allocate money for payment of bills was made by Alderman -Davis ----. Seconded by Alderman--Jones--. The motion passed with --5 -- yeas and 0 nays.

The next order of business is the standing committees and reports by council members.

The first report ---- Alderman Larry Plumlee reported that he had forgotten about the signs, so Alderman Curtis moved to table the motion indefinitely for street signs. Seconded by Alderman Davis. All members voted in the affirmative.

The second report by ---Mayor Morgan reported that Vicki Badley had decided to take the management of the concession stand for the summer.

The third report --Mayor Morgan reported that an ariel photo had been taken to start work on plats for the water system and the lawyer was starting on abstracts to determine ownership. Public meeting date of May 8th had been set. Meeting is to be announced on the radio and published in the newspaper about 10 days before the meeting.

The fourth report --- Alderman Gary High reported that the swings had been repaired and the sand box had been filled but the chat

for the bleacher area will be done later after the area has had the plastic applied to it.

#### NEW BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL

The first item of new business -- Request for repair on the White road east of Oak Grove. Possibly grade and gravel the road. Alderman Gary High would check on it and see what could be done with it.

The second item of new business----Firechief Ronald High requested permission to sell a water tank that had been on one of the old firetrucks. He thought the tank would sell for \$150-200 and also asked permission to use the money to paint the new firetruck.

The motion to grant permission to the firechief was made by Alderman Aaron Curtis. Seconded by Alderman Sam Jones. Vote taken 5 yeas and 0 nays.

The third item of new business --- Treasurer Ruth Callen reported that it was time to renew the workman's compensation. Alderman Curtis moved to renew workman's Compensation. Seconded by Alderman Davis. All members voted in the affirmative.

The final item of business was the financial report given by Treasurer Ruth Callen. The general fund has \$6,632.65. The street fund has \$12,522.34.

There being no other business to come before the council, Alderman - Curtis - moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Alderman - Plumlee -. All members voted in the affirmative and the meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
