OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: June 5, 1990

The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on June 5, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. in the town hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called - Alderman Aaron Curtis, Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Larry Plumlee, Alderman Gary High, Alderman Hugh Davis, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen, and Recorder Delma Allen. Fresent 8. Absent O.

The minutes for the May 1, 1990, meeting were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan ask for a vote. All members voted in the affirmative, and the minutes were approved as read.

The next item of business is the presentation of the monthly bills.

STANDING BILLS— Allied Telephone, Carroll Electric Cooperative, Maintenance on fire trucks. Maintenance on community grounds and ball park, and Empire Gas Company of Blue Eye, Mo.

NEW BILLS-- Walker Sales of Berryville and Nita-Faye Flowers(spray for Ira Allen). Motion to allocate money for payment of bills was made by Alderman Curtis. Seconded by Alderman Gary High. The motion passed with 5 yeas and 0 nays.

The next item of business is the standing committees and reports by council members.

First report was given by Mayor Morgan----the Mayor read a letter from the Governor.

Next the Mayor discussed the municipal election and the procedures to run for the office. After July 7th candidates can start soliciting signatures for petitions.

The third report was by Alderman Sam Jones. He reported that someone from the NWEDD is to be here on the 19th of June to determine where the water well will be located.

## NEW BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL

First item of new business——A review of the number of people that have signed up for water. Only sixty some people have signed up. It was decided that Mayor Morgan, Delma Allen, and Larry Plumlee would contact those who had not signed up.

The next item of new business was a report on the unsafe conditions of the door to an old cellar on the park grounds and a

back door to the community building is in poor condition and needs replaced. Some miscellaneous items for community building is also needed. Motion by Alderman Davis to have S.J.Jones contact R.D. High about doing the repair and to get the other repair jobs completed also. Seconded by Alderman Plumlee. On call for a vote, the motion passed with 5 yeas and 0 nays.

The financial report was General fund has \$6,265.97 and the street fund has \$13,247.87

There being no other business to come before the council, Alderman - Curtis - moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Alderman - Plumlee-. All members voted in the affirmative and the meeting adjourned at 9:26 p.m.
