

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

DATE: May 1, 1990

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The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on May 1, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. in the town hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called --Alderman Aaron Curtis, Alderman Hugh Davis, Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Gary High, Alderman Larry Plumlee, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen, and Recorder Delma Allen. Present 8. Absent 0.

Also in attendance were Lewis Epley, Attorney at Law, Richard Cantrell and Eddie Gore, who are with McGoodwin, Williams and Yates Engineering Firm, and Jack Chapman from the NWEDD in Harrison.

The minutes for the April 3, 1990, meeting were read and there being --no -- corrections or alterations, Alderman --Curtis-- moved to approve the minutes as read and Alderman --High-- seconded. All members voted in the affirmative.

The next item of business is the presentation of the monthly bills.

STANDING BILLS-- Allied Telephone, Carroll Electric Cooperative, Maintenance on fire trucks. Maintenance on community grounds and ball park, and Empire Gas Company of Blue Eye, Mo.

NEW BILLS-- Walker Sales, to be paid when the bill is received. R & R Gravel, Ozark Fire Extinguisher, Oak Grove Garage, and Maverick Supply. -----

----- Motion to allocate money for payment of bills was made by Alderman --High ---. Seconded by Alderman--Curtis--. The motion passed with --5 -- yeas and 0 nays.

The next item of business is the standing committees and reports by council members.

The first report ---- Alderman Gary High reported that he had put two loads of gravel on White Road and would wait to see if it needed more when the gravel was packed down. He thought the two loads would probably fix the potholes.

The second report by ---Mayor Morgan reported that Vicki Badley had changed her mind about taking the management of the concession stand for the summer, but the position has been filled.

The third report --Alderman Sam Jones reported that the firechief had not sold the tank that was removed from the firetruck and the new truck had not been painted.

The fourth report --- Alderman Gary High reported that the bleacher area of the ballpark had been graveled so the repair and improvements have been completed on park area.

NEW BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL

The first item of new business -- Jack Chapman from NWEDD in Harrison brought information about the water system. He stated that property owner will have expense of running line from meter to house . Low income families pay for meter deposit but can get help on the connection fees. Mr. Chapman will attend the May 8 public meeting and bring all the necessary forms to get customers signed up for water.

The second item of new business ---- Richard Cantrell presented the legal papers for a water user agreement and a right of way grant to be previewed by the council. The council, after previewing the papers, made two changes. Alderman Curtis moved to change the deposit to \$20 and the connection fee to \$60. Seconded by Alderman Davis. The vote was 5 yeas and 0 nays.

The final item of business was the financial report given by Treasurer Ruth Callen. The general fund has \$6,123.03. The street fund has \$12,936.45.

There being no other business to come before the council, Alderman - Curtis - moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Alderman - Jones -. All members voted in the affirmative and the meeting adjourned at 9:11 p.m.
