

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

DATE: November 6, 1990

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The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on November 6, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. in the town hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called - Alderman Aaron Curtis, Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Dean Stanphill, Alderman Gary High, Mayor Jean Morgan, and Recorder Delma Allen. Present 7. Absent 1. Alderman Hugh Davis absent.

Treasurer Ruth Callen was present

The minutes for the October 2, 1990, meeting were read. There was one correction or alteration to be made. The correction was in the first item of new business which should be as follows: In the report from Alderman High it should have read: Elbert Standlee does not want to handle the maintenance for the ballpark next year. After the correction was made, Mayor Morgan ask for a vote. All members voted in the affirmative, and the minutes were approved as corrected.

The next item of business was recognition of Lewis Epley, attorney for the Town of Oak Grove. In preparation for the city water system, the city needed protective covenants. Resolution #29 was presented to the council. Alderman Curtis moved to accept the resolution. Seconded by Alderman Jones. On the vote taken there were 4 yeas and no nays.

The next item for consideration was an ordinance #30 limiting the time within which the ordinances and resolutions of council might be subject to referendum. This being declared an emergency Alderman Stanphill moved to suspend the rule of reading an ordinance on three separate days. Seconded by Alderman High. The ordinance being placed for adoption, a roll call vote was taken. All members vote aye. None voted nay. A motion was made to suspend the rule before each reading and a roll call vote taken each time. Upon the third reading, the Mayor declared the Ordinance and the emergency clause adopted and signed the Ordinance.

The next item of business is the presentation of the monthly bills.

STANDING BILLS-- Allied Telephone, Carroll Electric Cooperative, Maintenance on fire trucks. Maintenance on community grounds and ball park, and Empire Gas Company of Blue Eye, Mo.

NEW BILLS-- . R.D.High for \$276.97 for handicapped ramp ,Steve Allen for labor and parts \$47.26, Chip and Seal for east road

\$4,876.38 AML fee of \$189.75. Motion to allocate money for payment of bills was made by Alderman -Curtis ---. Seconded by Alderman Stanphill. The motion passed with 4 yeas and 0 nays.

The next item of business is the standing committees and reports by council members. There being no reports, we went to the next item of business.

NEW BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL

No new business was brought before council

The financial report was General fund has \$7,498.78 and the street fund has \$15,785.72

There being no other business to come before the council, Alderman - Jones - moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Alderman - Curtis-. All members voted in the affirmative and the meeting adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
