

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on June 4th, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called - Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Hugh Davis, Alderman Gary High, Alderwoman Vickie Allen, Mayor Jean Morgan, and Treasurer Ruth Callen, Present 7. Absent 1. Alderman Aaron Curtis absent.

The minutes for the meeting on May 7th, 1991, were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan ask for a motion. Alderman Jones, seconded by Alderman Davis, moved to accept the minutes as read. All members voted in the affirmative, and the minutes were approved as read.

First item of business was a discussion about the \$20 per month the ball club and saddle club is to pay for ground maintenance. The clubs have not paid for April nor May. It was decided that a statement should be sent to them to remind them that they owe \$40

The next item of business was presentation of the bills. Carroll Electric, Oak Grove Garage, maintenance on fire trucks, Allied System; Walker Sales, J & B Mowing \$160, RCS Communications (Spfd Mo.) \$30 Alderwoman Allen, seconded by Alderman Jones, moved to allocate money for the bills. All members voted aye. None voted nay.

The next item of business was the reports by the Mayor

Schell should start drilling the well around June 5th.
Audit report should be received soon. No major problems
budget should be done with an ordinance and should be amended when unexpected expenses arise.

The next item of business was a discussion about a street light around the riding club arena for security. Alderman Davis, seconded by Jones, moved to have a light installed. All voted in the affirmative.

Alderman Jones reported that a tree was very dangerous and needs removed or cut the limbs that are dangerous.

Alderwoman Allen inquired about permission to paint and repair the front of the fire station. Steve Allen and Randy Sooter would donate their time to do the work. Alderwoman Allen, seconded by Jones, moved to grant permission for the repair work.

The final item of business was the financial report. The general fund has \$14,567.89. The street fund has \$14,426.45.

Motion to adjourn meeting by Alderman High. Seconded by Alderman Davis. All vote in the affirmative.
