

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

DATE: MARCH 5, 1991

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The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on March 5, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall for its regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members answered as their names were called - Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Aaron Curtis, Alderman Hugh Davis, Alderwoman Vickie Allen, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen, and Recorder Delma Allen. Present 7. Absent 1. Alderman Gary High.

The minutes for the meeting on February 5, 1991, were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan ask for a motion. Alderman Davis, seconded by Alderwoman Allen, moved to accept the minutes as read. All members voted in the affirmative, and the minutes were approved as read.

The next item of business was recognition of Bob and Janice Bilyeu who were interested in the job of ground maintenance for the Town Park. After a short discussion, Alderman Curtis, seconded by Alderman Jones, moved to make an oral contract with Mr. and Mrs. Bilyeu to keep the park mowed and the trash picked up as well as doing some repair work when needed. The oral contract for the job sets the hourly wage at \$5 per hour.

The next item of business was a request by the firechief for office supplies and other items needed by the firedepartment: card file, statement pad, receipts, a phone for the office, and an antenna for the two-way radio which they have borrowed and when funds are available the department needs a Stinger fan. Alderman Curtis, seconded by Alderwoman Allen, moved to approve purchases except the Stinger fan for the fire department. Vote was 4 yeas and no nays.

The next item of business was presentation of the bills. Carroll Electric, Oak Grove Garage, \$79.98 & \$40.00, maintenance on fire trucks, Beaver Lake Concrete \$91 (gravel for firedepartment parking area), Carroll County Newspapers, Walker Sales \$84.56, Green Forest Lumber, Plumlee Photography, Alderman Jones, seconded by Alderwoman Allen, moved to allocate money for the bills. All members voted aye. None voted nay.

The next business was a report by Larry and Gerl Swofford on the status of the ball club and the new managers for the summer ball league. The new managers are David Evans, secretary, Bryan and Jerry King, Mark Pearson, and Joe Doss. If the Town needs to contact the managers, call Jerry King after 5 p.m. at 438-6434.

The next item of business was a discussion on the best approach

to trash pick-up so the different groups using the park area would not have disagreements about who was responsible for trash left on the grounds. The final decision was to charge each group and the cookshack \$20.00 per month and that fee would be used to pay the grounds person to pick up all the trash after ballgames, horse shows, and ropings. Alderman Curtis, seconded by Alderman Jones, moved to approve the group for managers of the ballpark and to approve the \$20.00 charge for trash pick-up.

The final item of business is the financial report --- General fund has \$ 13,408.48 and the street fund has \$ 11,772.56.

There being no other business to come before the council, Alderman Curtis moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Alderwoman Allen. All members voted in the affirmative and the meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
