

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: Nov. 4th, 1991

The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met on November 4th, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall for a regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following members were present - Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Dean Stanphill, Alderwoman Vickie Allen, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen and Recorder Delma Allen. Aldermen Gary High and Hugh Davis were not in attendance. Present 6. Absent 2.

The minutes for the meeting on October 13, 1991, were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan ask for a motion. Alderwoman Allen, seconded by Alderman Stanphill, moved to accept the minutes as read. All members voted in the affirmative, and the minutes were approved as read.

The next item of business was presentation of the bills. After a short discussion, the council voted to join the Arkansas Municipal League for \$184.65 for the year of 1992. The other bills were Carroll Electric, Carroll County Newspaper, Apex waste Management Inc., insurance, backpack sprayer for the fire department, Oak Grove Grocery and Feed, Steve Allen, for maintenance on firetrucks. Alderwoman Allen, seconded by Alderman Jones, moved to allocate money for the bills. All voted in the affirmative.

The next business was recognition of delegations. Vern Asbury and Aaron Curtis came to voice a complaint about the placement of a fire hydrant on the east water line. Jackie Carrollton came to request the Council give consideration to extending the water line so that he could have access to city water. The council stated that they would have the supervisor and inspector check on both items. If it was feasible, the water line might be extended.

The first item of new business was a discussion about the radio that was loaned to the fire department. According to Alderwoman Allen and the firechief, the radio has not functioned correctly for some reason. Motion by Alderwoman Allen to repair the two-way radio which was donated to the fire department by the sheriff's department and return it to the sheriff. Seconded by Alderman Jones. All voted in the affirmative.

The next item was official recognition to Dean Stanphill for the donation of a portable water pump which was donated to the Town of Oak Grove by the Service Battery 1st/142.

Another item of business was a report that Argil Chaney would not sign a right of way waiver, but the Town had his permission to lay water line on his property. After a discussion on the legality of

crossing property without a waiver, the Council appointed Alderman Jones to check with the attorney. Motion by Alderman Stanphill, seconded by Alderwoman Allen, to cross Chaney's property with the approval by the Town's legal council. The vote was 3 ayes and no nays.

There was a short discussion about Adam Cline's delimia of getting water to recently purchased property. It was decided that he and others who have purchased property recently will be held to the terms of the water agreement that the Town made with FMHA.

The next item of business was reviewing the 1992 budget. Each member was given a copy of the proposed budget to review before the next meeting. Corrections and/or changes will be made at the Dec. meeting.

The final item of business was the financial report. The general fund has \$15,153.69 and the street fund has \$17,442.32.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Alderman Jones. Seconded by Alderwoman Vickie Allen. All voted in the affirmative. The meeting adjourned at 9:02.
