

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

DATE: AUGUST 4, 1992

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON AUGUST 4, 1992, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT- ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, ALDERWOMAN VICKE ALLEN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND RECORDER PAT CALTON. ALDERMAN DEAN STANDPHILL WAS ABSENT.

THE MINUTES WERE READ AND APPROVED FOR THE JULY 7, 1992 MEETING.

THE BILLS WERE PRESENTED, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THEM. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION AND ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE TO DO SO.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS OLD BUSINESS. LONNIE NICHOLS WAS APPROACHED BY VICKI ALLEN AS TO THE LEGALITY OF PARENTS NOT SUPERVISING THEIR CHILDREN PROPERLY. SHE WAS ADVISED TO CONTACT ANYONE SEEING THE CHILDREN NOT BEING SUPERVISED TO CONTACT THE SOCIAL SERVICES. HE ALSO TOLD VICKI THAT FRANK DICKERSON, OUR TOWN CONSTABLE, HAS THE SAME AUTHORITY AS THE SHERIFF AS LONG AS HE STAYS IN OUR DISTRICT.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS NEW BUSINESS. JERRY BLACKSON TALKED TO VICKI ABOUT PEOPLE THAT WORK OUT COURT COMMITMENT OR PUBLIC SERVICE, DOING SOME WORK FOR OAK GROVE. THE COUNCIL AGREED THAT WOULD BE A GOOD SERVICE. VICKI WAS GIVEN A LIST OF WORK THAT COULD BE DONE AND WILL GIVE IT TO JERRY.

MAYOR MORGAN TOLD ALDERMAN SAM JONES THAT HE AND WATER SUPER. RON HIGH SHOULD GIVE THE AUTHORIZATION TO PERSONS TO ACQUIRE BULK WATER. TAX SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE BILL.

MAYOR MORGAN IS TO CALL HARRISON HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND ASK THEM TO COME OUT AND CHECK WHAT CAN BE DONE TO ALLEVIATE WATER THAT STANDS IN DITCH WEST OF FIRE STATION.

RECORDER PAT CARLTON IS TO CHECK WITH DEAN MUEHLER ABOUT A BOOKING SYSTEM THAT CAN BE SET UP WITH SOFTWARE.

BECAUSE OF THE ABSENTS OF EITHER A COUNCIL MEMBER OR THE MAYOR THE REVIEW OF PAYMENT TO WATER CLERK PAT CARLTON AND WATER SUPT. RON HIGH. (PAT AND RON HAVE RECEIVED BONUSES FOR THE EXTRA HOURS INVOLVED IN GETTING THE SYSTEM SET UP) *hasid been received* ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO GIVE RUTH CALLEN A BONUS FOR EXTRA HOURS SHE HAS PUT IN AS TREASURER. ALDERMAN PAT DAVIS SECONDED THE MOTION. RUTHS SALARY INCREASE WILL ALSO BE DISCUSSED AT THE NEXT MEETING.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH
SECONDED. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.
