

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Date: January 17th, 1992

The Oak Grove Town Council of the town of Oak Grove, Arkansas, met on January 17th, 1992, at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall for a called meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jean Morgan, presiding officer, and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following were present - Alderman Sam Jones, Alderman Dean Stanphill, Alderman Gary High, Alderwoman Vickie Allen, Mayor Jean Morgan, Treasurer Ruth Callen and Pat Davis, who was sworn in as alderwoman by Mayor Morgan to fill the unexpired term of her husband, Hugh Davis, deceased. The minutes for the meeting on January 7th, 1992, were read. Two corrections were made. The proposed purchase of the radios for the fire department was changed from the Carroll County Sheriffs Department to Randy's Wrecker Service. Due to bad weather, the meeting date was changed from Monday, January 13th to Friday, January 17th, 1992. After the corrections, the Mayor asked for a vote on the corrected minutes. All members voted in the affirmative and the minutes were approved as corrected.

The Mayor reported that she had arranged for the Computer Age at Harrison to deliver a computer to the Town Hall. This includes computer, printer, motem and battery back-up for a total of \$2341.75 and table for an additional \$80.00.

Alderman High reported that the Water Department might get a used night depository box to use for the water bills through the First National Bank at Berryville. After a discussion, motion was made by Alderman Jones and seconded by Alderman Stanphill that Alderman High go ahead and get the night depository box. All Aldermen voted in the affirmative.

Alderman Allen presented a copy of ordinance for animal control that Berryville uses, as a suggestion as to what the Town of Oak Grove might do. No action was taken at this time.

Alderwoman Allen reported that the Fire Department is still checking on buying radios.

There was only one bill presented for payment - the water bill for Community Building. Alderman Stanphill moved and Alderwoman Allen seconded that the bill be paid. All members voted in the affirmative.

Four applications for Water Department Clerk were presented for consideration: Patsy A. Carlton, Janet A. Stanphill, Timothy Ray Stroud and Genevieve B. Sooter. Voting was by secret ballot, with Janet A. Stanphill receiving one vote and Patsy A. Carlton with four votes will be the Water Department Clerk.

Alderwoman Allen, Seconded by Alderwoman Davis, moved to adjourn. All members voted in the affirmative. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.

Financial report - general fund has \$15,855.51 and street fund has \$19,431.54.
