

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
DATE: AUG. 3, 1993

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON AUG. 3, 1993, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT- MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE LAST MONTHS MINUTES. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ AND ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I ALL OPPOSED THE SAME. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR SAY I ALL OPPOSED THE SAME, ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERMAN GARY HIGH TRIED TO CLEAN SOME OF THE DITCH LINE DRAINAGE BEHIND THE TOWN HALL BUT IT IS STILL TOO WET, IT WAS DISCUSSED WHAT IS THE BEST WAY TO DRAIN. JACK NEWMAN WHO HAS EXPERIENCE WITH A GRADER WILL BE ASKED TO DO SOME WORK ON IT, AND ALDERMAN SAM JONES WILL CONTACT THE COUNTY JUDGE ABOUT USING THE COUNTY GRADER. PHILLIPS WILL BE CONTACTED ABOUT DRAINAGE ON THEIR PROPERTY. HARLEN POWERS CAN CONTACT THE FORMAN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE MOTION TO DO SO, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED SAME, ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERWOMAN VICKE ALLEN MADE MOTION THAT THE COUNCIL SEE ABOUT GETTING A SAFETY MAGNETIC SIGN FOR RODNEY NEWMAN'S TRUCK, TO BE IDENTIFIED AS THE OAK GROVE WATER SUPERINTENDANT WHEN DOING WORK AND READING METERS. ALSO ONE AMBER LIGHT AND TWO PYLONS. ALSO SEE JERRY BLACKSTON ABOUT PRINTING SIGN FOR THE FRONT OF TOWN HALL THAT HAS THE PHONE NUMBER FOR THE CITY HALL AND THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME SIGN, ALL VOTED WITH I.

FIRE CHIEF RON HIGH TOLD THE COUNCIL OF SOME STATE MONEY THAT IS AVAILABLE COMING FROM TAX ON FIRE INSURANCE COMPANYS. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT HAS TO BE CERTIFIED. ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS MADE MOTION THAT THE COUNCIL AUTHORIZE MONEY FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO UP GRADE WHAT IS NECESSARY TO GET CERTIFIED. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED BY SAME, ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ADJOURN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS SECONDED, ALL IN FOVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME,

ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
