

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: DECEMBER 7, 1993

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON DECEMBER 7, 1993 FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE RPRESENT...MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. THE MINUTES WERE READ. ONE CORRECTION WAS MADE, ON THE AMMENDED BUDGET FOR THE TOWN, IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN THE \$2750.00 BE PUT IN THE PARKS AND RECREATION COLUMN FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT COLUMN. DO YOU ACCEPT AS READ WITH THE CORRECTION? ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE MOTION TO ACCEPT. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL VOTED I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF BILLS. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEV TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL VOTED I.

IT WAS APPROVED FOR AN APPRECIATION DINNER FOR THE TOWN COUNCIL AND THE FIREMEN AND THEIR FAMILIES TO BE HELD IN DECEMBER. THIS COMES OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. TRACI WALKER WAS PRESENT AND TALKED TO THE COUNCIL OF THE STENCH THAT IS ALMOST UNBEARAVLE WHEN LIQUID CHICKEN LITTER IS PUT ON THE FIELDS AROUND THEIR HOME. WONDERED IF THERE IS AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT SUCH IN THE TOWN LIMITS. MAYOR MORGAN WILL CALL OFFICIALS TO FIND OUT IF SOMETHING CAN BE DONE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
