THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON JUNE 1,1993, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL SAID I. WATER SUPERTINDENT RODNEY NEWMAN NEEDS AN EXTRA \$50.00 FOR OVERTIME SPENT ON HIS JOB.
ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE MOTION TO DO SO AND ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR I. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

GREER CONSTRUCTION OF GREEN FOREST WHO RECIEVED PAYMENT FROM THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE FOR WORK ON THE WATER DEPARTMENT AND FROM BB&B, Ø HAS BEEN NOTIFIED BY THIS DEPARTMENT ASKING FOR A REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE OVERPAYMENT AND WE HAVE HAD NO RESPONSE. MAYOR MORGAN, SEND HIM A BILL BY CERT. FIFIED MAIL. TELLING HIM IF HE DOES NOT RESPOND WITHIN 30 DAYS THE BILL WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE SMALL CLAIMS COURT.
