

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
DATE MARCH 2, 1993

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON MARCH 2, 1993, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT- MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, RECORDER PAT CARLTON. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL AND RECORDER *Treasurer* RUTH CALLEN WERE ABSENT.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE LAST MINUTES. MAYOR MORGAN ASKED FOR A VOTE FOR THE MINUTES TO BE ACCEPTED AS READ AND ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF BILLS. TREASURER RUTH CALLEN BEING ABSENT MENT SOME OF THE BILLS WILL HAVE TO WAIT TILL HER RETURN AND COUNCIL THINKS THE RECORDERS NAME SHOULD BE PUT ON THE ACCOUNT SO SHE COULD PAY THE BILLS IN THE ABSENCE OF THE TREASURER. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT USED A ROLL OF STAMPS THAT BELONGED TO THE WATER DEPARTMENT. TOWN ACCOUNT NEEDS TO RE-IMBURSE WATER DEPT FOR THEM. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE TO DO SO.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS OLD BUSINESS, MAYOR MORGAN SAID IT WAS A GOOD IDEA TO CHANGE THE ADDRESSES TO A MORE PRECISE ADDRESS BUT WAIT TILL 911 BECOMES EFFECTIVE AND FOR THE POSTMASTER TO GET IT IN MOTION AS IT TAKES QUITE A TIME TO MAKE THE CHANGES.

RON HIGH HAS PUT GRAVEL AT THE DORA LEE BUTLER AND HELEN ATCHISON PLACE.

NEXT WAS NEW BUSINESS. NEEDS TO HAVE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS PUT ON STATE HIGHWAY 221 NORTH OF TOWN AND ON COUNTY ROAD 85. MAYOR MORGAN WILL CALL STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SEE ABOUT IT. DISCUSSION WAS HELD ABOUT SOMETHING FOR TOWN TO USE TO OPEN DRIVEWAYS WHEN SNOW AND ICE HAS BEEN PUSHED INTO THEM BY THE SNOWPLOWS. MAYBE A BLADE COULD BE ATTACHED TO THE FIRE TRUCKS. WILL CHECK ON IT BEFORE NEXT YEAR. THE BALL GROUNDS NEEDS SOME REPAIRS, BACK SCREEN AND FENCE NEEDS REPAIRS AND BLEACHERS NEEDS FIXING. THE TOWN WILL ALLOCATE MONEY TO REPAIR IF THE BALL ORGANIZATION WILL DO THE WORK. RODNEY NEWMAN AND LARRY SWOFFORD ARE INTERESTED IN WORKING WITH THE BALL TEAMS. LARRY WAS CALLED AND HE SAID HE WOULD BE GLAD TO WORK WITH RODNEY AND TRY TO GET THE WORK DONE. ALDERMAN GARY MOVED TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO DO THIS AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I.
