

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: SEPT.7,1993

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON SEPT.7,1993, FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT-- MAYOR, JEAN MORGAN- ALDERWOMAN, PAT DAVIS- ALDERWOMAN, VICKI ALLEN- ALDERMAN, SAM JONES- ALDEREMAN, GARY HIGH - TREASURER, RUTH CALLEN - RECORDER, PAT CARLTON. ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL WAS ABSENT.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. THE MINUTES WERE READ AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ AND ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE TO ACCEPT AS READ. THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF AUG.19,1993 WAS READ AND ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IS STILL WORKING ON THE CERTIFICATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT: STILL WORKING ON UPGRADING THE DEPARTMENT (MEN AND EQUIPMENT). FAITH PARTON IS INTERESTED IN BECOMMING THE SECRETARY FOR THE DEPARTMENT. NEW OFFICERS WERE VOTED IN.

DO WE WANT THE SAME INSURANCE AND SAME AMOUNT OF INSURANCE? ALDERMAN SAM JONES VOTED TO STAY THE SAME. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED BY SAME. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

SOME MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL HAVE BEEN APPROACHED WITH COMPLLAINTS OF DOGS RUNNING LOOSE AND BEING A NUSIANCE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE MOTION THAT WE PUT A NOTICE ON THE BACK OF THE WATER WILLS INFORMING PEOPLE OF THE PROBLEM. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THE NOTICE WILL READ, COMPLAINTS HAVE BEEN MADE OF DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE, DESTROYING PROPERTY AND SCATTERING TRASH, PLEASE HELP US CONTROL THIS PROBLEM. MAYOR,JEAN MORGAN

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ADJOURN AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY, ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
