

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: APRIL 14, 1994

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE MET ON APRIL 14, 1994 FOR A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. DAVE TIPPET AND JOE SALE WITH JOE AND SANDRA SWOFFAR WERE PRESENT TO TALK ABOUT THE WATER BEING RUN TO THE PROPERTY THAT TIPPET AND SALE HAVE BOUGHT. JOE IS A ARCHITECT FROM LITTLE ROCK. HE WILL DRAW UP A PROPOSAL FOR A MASTER PLAN (NO COST TO THE TOWN) FOR WATER SEWER ETC. FOR THE TIPPET-SALE PROPERTY. HE WILL ALSO CHECK TO SEE IF FUNDS AND OR GRANTS ARE AVAILABLE FOR THE TOWN. TIPPET AND SALE WANT TO KNOW WHAT THE TOWN WILL DO TO HELP THEM FINANCIALLY WITH PUTTING IN THE WATER TO THE PROPERTY. LARRY SWOFFARD WAS PRESENT AND HE WILL TALK TO THE COUNTY JUDGE ABOUT A GRANT FOR A SEWER SYSTEM. MAYOR MORGAN WILL CHECK AND SEE IF THE ROAD TO ALDEN MC CREARY PROPERTY BELONGS TO THE TOWN.

THE DELEGATION WAS DISMISSED AND AFTER MUCH DISCISSION ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL MADE A MOTION THAT THE WATER DEPARTMENT WOULD PAY A MAXIMUM OF \$1,000.00 OF THE TOTAL COST TOWARD THE WATER EXTENSTION TO THE TIPPET-SALE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL OPPOSED IN THE SAME. ALL VOTED I.

ALDERMAN GARY HIGH TOLD THE COUNCIL THAT ACCORDING TO AR. STATE CODE, ALL WATER LINES MUST BE 10' FROM SEWER LINES. IF YOU HAVE AN OUTSIDE HYDRANT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CHECK VALVE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
