

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: APRIL 5, 1994

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON APRIL 5, 1994 FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN DEAN STAMPHILL, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. MINUTES WERE READ AND ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE MOTION TO ACCEPT AS SUCH AND ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME, ALL SAID I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS OLD BUSINESS. THE TREE IN FRONT OF BRASWELLS HOME HAS BEEN TAKEN CARE OF. WORK WAS DONE IN FRONT OF JIMMY WHITE HOME, IN FRONT OF BUSTER WOOD PLACE AND IN FRONT OF GARY HIGH PROPERTY. GOT A FRANCHISE CHECK FROM CABLE T.V. DO WE WANT TO JOIN THE RURAL AR. WATER ASSOCIATION AGAIN? ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO JOIN, ALDERMAN DEAN STANPHILL SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. ALL SAID I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. ALL SAID I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. DAVE TIPPET AND JOE SALE ARE INTERESTED IN GETTING WATER TO A 80 ACRE PIECE OF LAND THEY HAVE PURCHASDED, AND ARE CONSIDERING SELLING LOTS OFF IT. AFTER A DISCUSSION THEY WERE TOLD THAT WE WOULD LET THEM KNOW AFTER WE REVIEW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS. CHARLES YOUNG WAS PRESENT TO SEE IF ANYTHING CAN BE DONE ABOUT THE FAST TRAFFIC THRU THE TOWN. THE MAYOR WILL CONTACT LONNIE NICKLES AND SEE IF HE CAN BE DO SOMETHING.
