

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: MARCH 1, 1994

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, MET ON MAR. 1, 1994 FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN, ALDERMAN DEAN STAMPHILL, ALDERMAN SAM JONES, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH, TREASURER RUTH CALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAME JONES MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE THE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. ALL VOTED I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. JIMMY MNCINTOSH, PERRY BUTLER, AND ALEX FOSTER MET WITH THE TOWN COUNCIL CONCERNING THE BALL PARK. RICHARD HAYES IS INTERESTED IN THE SNACK SHACK. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH TALK TO HIM AND TELL HIM THE DETAILS AND SEE IF HE CAN BE AVAILABLE FOR THESE HOURS AS HE WORKS NIGHTS AT ANOTHER JOB.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS THE MAYOR PRESENTED THE WATER MAIN EXTENSION POLICY FROM THE ENGINEERS OF MCGOODWIN, WILLIAMS AND YATES TO THE COUNCIL.
