

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
DATE: NOVEMBER 24, 1994

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR. MET ON NOVEMBER 24, 1994 IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A SPECIAL MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT. ALDERMEN SAM JONES, WILLARD STANDLEE AND GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN. TREASURER RUTH CALLEN AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON. L. EPLEY AND DAVE TIPPET MET WITH THE COUNCIL. TIPPET SAID THAT HIS PROPOSED HOUSING DEVELOPMENT IS PROGRESSING AND THE ANNEXATION INTO THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE IS READY. IT WILL GO BEFORE THE JUDGE JAN. 6, 1995. AFTER DISCUSSION OF THE SEWER AND EXTENSION LINES FOR THE TOWN, EPLEY ASKED THE COUNCIL IF THE TOWN IS INTERESTED IN TIPPETS SEWER. THE TOWN DECLINED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SEWER PLANS AS OF NOW.
