THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR. MET ON MAY 2,1995, AT 7:00 P.M., IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.
