

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: OCTOBER 3, 1995

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON OCTOBER 3, 1995 AT 7:00 P.M., IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, WILLARD STANDLEE AND GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE MINUTES FOR THE MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 3, 1995, WERE READ. THERE BEING NO CORRECTIONS OR ALTERATIONS, MAYOR MORGAN ASK FOR A MOTION. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE, AND THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED AS READ.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE MADE MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

FIRE CHIEF FRANK ALLEN GAVE THE COUNCIL A PROPOSAL FOR RADIO EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND FOR F.C.C. LICENSE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO AUTHORIZE A CHECK TO PAY FOR THE LICENSE. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE SECONDED. THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL AYES. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION FOR THE CHIEF TO GO AHEAD WITH PLANS TO PURCHASE THE RADIO EQUIPMENT. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE SECONDED. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

MAYOR MORGAN READ ORDINANCE #51-95 FOR THE PASSING OF A 5 MILL TAX AGAINST THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE FOR THE YEAR 1996. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE ORDINANCE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THERE WAS A DISCUSSION CONCERNING THE EMUS BEING RAISED ON THE MARVIN AND LINDA PHILLIPS PROPERTY. THE COUNCIL THINKS LAWYER EPLEY NEEDS TO LOOK INTO THE LEGALITIES OF THE SITUATION. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN IS TO GET IN CONTACT WITH MR. EPLEY.

ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. MEETING ADJOURNED AT 9:00 P.M. NEXT MEETING WILL BE NOVEMBER 7, 1995.
