

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DATE: SEPTEMBER 5, 1995

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON SEPTEMBER 5, 1995 AT 7:00 P.M., IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES AND GARY HIGH. WILLARD STANDLEE WAS ABSENT. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE MINUTES FOR THE MEETING ON JULY 3, 1995, WERE READ. THERE BEING NO CORRECTIONS OR ALTERATIONS, MAYOR MORGAN ASK FOR A MOTION. ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS, SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MOVED TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE, AND THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED AS READ. THERE WAS NO MEETING IN THE MONTH OF AUGUST.

THE SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE INSURANCE ON THE COMMUNITY BUILDING IS DUE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE INSURANCE AND THE REGULAR BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION . THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL AYES.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF JEANETTE PARTON. SHE WANTED TO KNOW IF THEY WOULD BE ABLE TO GET WATER IF AND WHEN THEY ANNEXED THEIR PROPERTY INTO THE TOWN. YES, THEY WILL BE ABLE TO GET WATER.

THE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND THE BASKETBALL GOALS AT THE COMMUNITY BUILDING IS NEEDING REPAIRS. A FENCE NEEDS TO BE PUT ON THE GROUNDS TO KEEP CARS OFF. RODNEY NEWMAN HAS AGREED TO DO THE WORK. THE BUILDING NEEDS SOME WORK DONE ALSO. ASK HAROLD SOOTER ABOUT DOING IT.

GARY KLEIN HAS ASKED ABOUT GETTING A LARGE AMOUNT OF WATER FROM THE TOWN. HE CAN GET THE WATER AT THE HYDRANTS AND IT WILL HELP TO FLUSH THE LINES. HE IS TO USE DIFFERENT HYDRANTS EACH TIME, KEEP A RECORD OF WHICH ONES HE USES AND AMOUNT HE USES. CHARGE HIM \$3.50 A THOUSAND. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO DO SO. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS MADE A MOTION TO GIVE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT PERMISSION TO GET LETTERING FOR THE FIRE TRUCKS AND NEW TIRES. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MOVED TO ADJOURN, SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS. ALL MEMBERS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. MEETING ADJOURNED AT 9:00 P.M.
