

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: APRIL 2, 1996

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON APRIL 2, 1996 AT 7:00 P.M., IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDING OFFICER, MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, WILLARD STANDLEE AND GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN. PAT CARLTON RECORDER.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MEETING MINUTES. THE MINUTES WERE READ. THERE BEING NO CORRECTIONS OR ALTERATIONS, MAYOR MORGAN ASK FOR A MOTION. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

MAYOR MORGAN HAS SET A DATE FOR RABBIES SHOTS AND COGGINS TEST FOR APRIL 20, FROM 12:00 TO 2:00. APRIL 27 IF RAIN.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS; THE RURAL FIRE TRUCK NEEDS TWO FRONT TIRES. THE LETTERING NEEDS TO BE DONE ON DOORS OF TANKER. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE MADE A MOTION TO GET THIS DONE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL COUNCIL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SAID THE FIRE DEPARTMENT NEEDS A SECRETARY. EUGENE REYNOLDS HAS DONE WORK FOR THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT THINKS GENE WOULD MAKE A GOOD SECRETARY. FAITH PARTON HAS BEEN PART TIME SECRETARY FOR THE DEPARTMENT. VICKI, TALK TO FAITH ABOUT TURNING HER PART OVER TO EUGENE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL COUNCIL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF DELEGATION. RON AND TONY HIGH MET WITH THE COUNCIL ABOUT GETTING LAND ANNEXED TO GET WATER TO HIS PROPERTY. THE PROPERTY BETWEEN HIS LAND AND EXISTING ANNEXED LAND IS NOT ANNEXED. IT BELONGS TO HIS BROTHER AND HE DOES NOT WANT TO BE IN THE CITY LIMITS BUT WILL ~~Annex~~ ^{Annex} ENOUGH LAND TO CONNECT TO EXISTING ANNEXED LAND. HOW MUCH LAND DOES LAW REQUIRE? WILL CALL LAWYER EPLEY AND FIND OUT. RON WANTS TO KNOW IF THE TOWN WILL HELP PAY FOR WATER CONSTRUCTION COSTS. MAYOR MORGAN TOLD HIM THEY WOULD TALK ABOUT IT.

MAYOR MORGAN BROUGHT UP THE EMU ISSUE FOR DISCUSSION. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO GO AHEAD WITH THE MUNICIPALE COURT. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
