

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: FEBRUARY 6, 1996

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON FEBRUARY 6, 1996, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, WILLARD STANDLEE, GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN, AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL COUNCIL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

LEAH MORGAN IS INTERESTED IN HAVING A COMMUNITY EGG HUNT AT THE COMMUNITY BUILDING AROUND EASTER. THE COUNCIL THINKS IT IS A GOOD IDEA.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. RON AND TONY HIGH MET WITH THE COUNCIL TO DISCUSS GETTEING WATER TO THEIR PROPERTY. THE PROPERTY IS NOT IN THE TOWN LIMITS AND DOES NOT JOIN ANY LAND THAT IS IN TOWN LIMITS. MARVIN AND LINDA PHILLIPS MET WITH THE COUNCIL WITH MORE QUESTIONS AND DISCUSSIONS ON THE LEGALITY OF THE RAISING OF EMUS. THEY WANT A VARIANCE OF THE TOWNS ORDIANCE. THE COUNCIL SAYS NO. MAYOR MORGAN READ A LETTER FROM LAWYER LEWIS EPLEY. SEE IF TIM MC KINNY, MAYOR OF BERRYVILLE AR., IS AGREEABLE TO SHARE KENT COXSEY AS MUNICIPLE JUDGE FOR THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE. IF HE AGREES LEWIS EPLEY WILL PREPARE PAPERS TO SET UP A MUNICIPLE COURT TO ENFORCE MUNICIPLE ORDINANCE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE REGULAR BILLS WERE PRESENTED AND A BILL FOR THE INSURANCE ON THE PUMP. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. MEETING ADJOURNED AT 10:00.
