

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DATE: MARCH 5, 1996

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON MARCH 5, 1996, AT 7:00 P.M., IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, WILLARD STANDLEE AND GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKI ALLEN. RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE LAST MEETING MINUTES. THE MINUTES WERE READ. THERE BEING NO CORRECTIONS OR ALTERATIONS, MAYOR MORGAN ASK FOR A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES. ALDERMAN GARY GARY MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE <sup>RECOGNITION</sup> OF DELEGATION. JEFF JONES MET WITH THE COUNCIL TO DISCUSS PLANS FOR STARTING BALL GAMES AT THE COMMUNITY GROUNDS AND WOULD LIKE SOME HELP FROM THE TOWN FOR EXPENSES. WOULD THE TOWN PAY THE ELECTRIC BILL. THE MAYOR SAID THAT THE TOWN MAINTAINS THE FIXED ASSETS AND DOESN'T THINK IT CAN DO ANY MORE. SEE ABOUT CUTTING COSTS AND WE CAN CALL ANOTHER MEETING TO APPROVE THE PLANS.

DALLAS TIBBETS MEET WITH THE COUNCIL. HE IS UPSET THAT THE COUNCIL DIDN'T TELL HIM THAT ACCORDING TO ORDINANCE NO. 20, <sup>called</sup> EMUS CANNOT BE RAISED IN THE CITY LIMITS OF OAK GROVE. HE ~~HAD~~ <sup>the</sup> MET WITH MAYOR, JEAN MORGAN AND WAS TOLD TO GET A COPY OF THE ORDINANCE FROM PAT CARLTON (WHICH HE DID) AND THAT WE WERE LOOKING INTO THE LEGALITIES OF IT NOW. HE SAID HE HAD TO GO TO A LAWYER TO BE TOLD AND THINKS THE TOWN SHOULD PAY HIS LEGAL FEES. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, HE AGREED TO LET THE COSTS DROP BUT WANTED A PROMISE THAT HE WOULD BE NOTIFIED WHEN AND IF WE GO TO COURT ABOUT THE MATTER.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. PAT CARLTON WAS GIVEN PERMISSION TO GET LEGAL HELP FOR TAX PURPOSES.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO GIVE THE MAYOR A SALARY OF \$100.00 PER MONTH. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I.

ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKI ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. MEETING ADJORNED AT 9:30 P.M.
