

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: OCTOBER 1, 1996

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 1, 1996, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN GARY HIGH, SAM JONES AND WILLARD STANDLEE, ALDERWOMEN PAT DAVIS AND VICKIE ALLEN, RECORDER PAT CARLTON AND WATER SUPERTINDENT RODNEY NEWMAN.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF SEPTEMBER 3, 1996 MINUTES. ARE THERE ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? NONE. THE MAYOR ASKED FOR A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THEM AS READ, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE INSURANCE THAT WE HAVE ON THE COMMUNITY BUILDING HAS NO PROVISIONS FOR VANDALISM. WE TOOK OUT THE \$6.00 PER THOUSAND WITH \$500.00 DEDUCTABLE. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN WILL CALL CARROLL ELECTRIC ABOUT THE INSTALLATION OF THE CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS, ALSO ABOUT PURCHASING ADDITIONAL DECORATIONS THAT BERRYVILLE DISPOSED OF. CALL AMERICAN DUMPSTERS AND HAVE THE DUMPSTER PICKED UP AT THE END OF THE MONTH. THE ALDERMEN ARE TO CHECK ABOUT GETTING A NEW STOVE AND PIPES FOR THE COMMUNITY BUILDING. IF YOU FIND A GOOD DEAL GO AHEAD AND GET IT. ALDERMAN WILLARD STANDLEE MADE A MOTION TO PURCHASE A STOVE AND PIPES, ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR, SAY I. ALL SAID I.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE INSURANCE FROM THE MUNICIPAL LEAGUE WAS PRESENTED BEFORE THE COUNCIL. WE ARE PAYING \$157.75 JUST FOR THEIR SERVICES. IF WE WANT THE MUNICIPAL LEGAL DEFENSE PROGRAM, IT WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL \$346.50. CHECK ON SOME OTHER POSSIBILITIES FOR A CHECK OF THE WATER DEPARTMENT BOOKS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE ABOVE BILLS AND THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS, ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF BONNIE OTT. SHE WAS STILL QUESTIONING THE JUNK ACROSS THE STREET OF LEROY BARNES. ESTELLE PHILLIPS AND TONY HAYDEN WERE PRESENT.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN PAT DAVIS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. ALL SAID I. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
