

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE MAY JUNE 3, 1997

THE OAK GROVE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON JUNE 3, 1997, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH, AND GENE REYNOLDS. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH. RECORDER PAT CARLTON. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN CAME IN A LITTLE LATE.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE MINUTES OF LAST MONTHS MEETING. THE MINUTES WERE READ. IS THERE ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? NONE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH QUESTIONED WHAT THE TREE TRIMING BILL WAS FOR. SHE WAS TOLD IT WAS FOR WORK JEFF JONES WAS HAVING DONE AS PART OF HIS WORK FOR THE BALL PARK. HE HAS USED ALL HIS MONEY HE WAS ALLOTTED TO USE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. TRUCKS, FIRE MASTER FOR THE FIRE DEPT.; TO GARY HIGH FOR WORK DONE AT THE COMMUNITY BLDG. AND NEW CHURCH HOUSE INSPECTION AND TO KENNETH HIGH FOR WORK DONE ON COMMUNITY BLDG. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE SAID I. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

NEW BUSINESS: THE MAYOR THANKS ESPECIALLY GARY AND SAM FOR HELPING WITH THE TRASH PICK UP. SORRY ITS HASN'T BEEN PICKED UP YET BUT THEY PROMISED AND HAVEN'T. WILL CALL AGAIN. THE TOWN TRACTOR IS NOT WORKING AND RODNEY IS HAVING TO USE HIS PERSONAL MOWER TO MOW WITH. COMPENSATE HIM AN EXTRA \$2.00 PER HOUR. (\$7.00 INSTEAD OF \$5.00). SEE IF STEVE AND FRANK WILL LOOK AT THE MOWER AND GET IT TO WORK FOR THE DURATION OF THE SUMMER AND IF IT NEEDS AN OVERHAULING, IT CAN BE DONE DURING THE WINTER MONTHS. A SIGN IS BEING MADE FOR THE COMMUNITY GROUNDS. "NO TRESPASSING AFTER 10:00 P.M.". THE FIRE DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN UPGRADED FROM A 9\9 TO A 8\9 CLASSIFICATION.
