

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
DATE: NOV. 5, 1997

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET AT 7:00 P.M. AT THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAM MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT. ALDERMEN SAM JONES AND EUGENE REYNOLDS, ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN. RECORDER PAT CARLTON AND WATER SUPERINTENDENT RODNEY NEWMAN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH WAS ABSENT.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MEETING. THE MINUTES WERE READ. YOU HAVE HEARD THE READING OF THE MINUTES, ARE THERE ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? NONE. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THEM AS READ, ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. *Three* I'S. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE DISCUSSION OF THE OVERHEAD DOORS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. THE BILL FROM HARRISON OVERHEAD DOOR WAS PRESENTED. EUGENE REYNOLDS CALLED FIVE BUSINESSES AND THIS WAS THE ONLY ONE THAT GAVE A BID. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT HARRISON OVERHEAD DOOR TO INSTALL THE DOORS AND EQUIPMENT. A BILL FROM CARROLL CO. NEWSPAPERS, MUNICIPLE LEAGUE, BYTE SIZE COMPUTERS, HAROLD SOOTER, FIRE HOUSE INSURANCE, AR. RURAL WATER ASSOCIATION AND A BILL FOR BULBS AND A BILL FOR ~~GAS~~ <sup>Lunch</sup> USED TO CHECK ON THE TRACTOR, WHICH IS RE-IMBURSED TO EUGENE REYNOLDS. CALL EMPIRE GAS AND HAVE THEM CHECK ON THE HEATER IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION ABOUT A TRACTOR ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO VOTE ON A KABOTA. ONE FOR AND TWO NAY.
