

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: JUNE 7, 1998

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON JUNE 7, 1998, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS. ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN (LATE).

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MEETINGS. ANY OMISSIONS OR CORRECTIONS? NONE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ FOR THE MEETING OF MAY 5. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MAY 13 MINUTES AND ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

RECORDER PAT CARLTON READ A LETTER FROM JOHN BRADFORD, AUDITOR, FOR THE WATER DEPT. THE LETTER WAS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS. THE ROOFS AT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNITY BUILDING HAVE HAIL DAMAGE, CALL THE INSURANCE COMPANY'S.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE PRESENTED TO COUNCIL AND THEY WERE INITIALIZED. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF DELEGATION. ANNA MATTHEWS FROM C.C. NEWSPAPER WAS PRESENT. JEANETTE PARTON WAS QUESTIONING THE LEGALITY OF THE TOWN PAYING A BILL TO ALLTEL. IT WAS BILLED TO THE CITY, GARY HIGH DAMAGED THE LINE WHILE DIGGING, THE WORK HAD BEEN ORDERED. SHE ALSO QUESTIONED THE LEGALITY OF COUNCILMEN WORKING FOR THE CITY. GARY HIGH DOING WORK AND EUGENE REYNOLDS WORKING AS A SECRETARY FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR PAY. SHE WAS TOLD TO COME BACK NEXT MONTH AND WE WOULD HAVE A ORDINANCE TO TAKE CARE OF THIS. SHE THOUGHT OTHER PEOPLE SHOULD BE ABLE TO BID FOR A JOB WHEN ONE COMES OPEN. HER HUSBAND HAS A BACK HOE BUT IS NOT LICENSED. THE MAYOR ASSURED HER THAT LAWYER EPLEY IS WORKING ON ALL THIS.

ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. ALL OPPOSED BY THE SAME.
