

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DATE: MAY 5, 1998

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON MAY 5, 1998, IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH, ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN WAS LATE. RECORDER PAT CARLTON AND WATER SUPERTINDENT RODNEY NEWMAN.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE APRIL MINUTES. THE MINUTES WERE READ. ALDERMAN SAM JONES QUESTIONED HOW JEFF JONES WAS TO KEEP THE LIGHTS FOR THE BALL FIELD. THE MINUTES WERE AMENDED TO INCLUDE "OR KEEP RECORD OF HOURS USED" WITH THE READING OF THE METER. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS AMENDED. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. A CHECK FROM FUGETT FOR BALL FIELD LIGHT WAS PRESENTED. THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS AND A BILL FROM EPLEY WERE PRESENTED. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

MRS MORGAN GOT A LETTER FROM R.E.A. VERIFYING THAT THEY HAD REPAIRED 20 STREET LIGHTS THE FIRST TIME AND 10 THE SECOND TIME. SHE WENT TO THE POLICE WITH THIS AND SOME ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND TALKED TO A DEPUTY AND HE SAID HE WOULD CHECK INTO THE VANDALISM OF THE LIGHTS. EUGENE SAID THE ONE OUT BY DON YOUNGBLOODS HAS NOT BEEN REPAIRED. WILL TRY AND SEE IF ANY MORE ARE OUT. THE MAYOR HAS COME UPON A PROPOSITION FROM A ANONYMOUS DONOR WHO WILL DONATE TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A FIRE TRUCK, IF THE LOCAL PEOPLE WILL MATCH IT, DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR. THAT DOESN'T MEAN ANY MONEY WE HAVE OR FUND RAISERS WE HAVE PLANNED. LORENE NICHOLSON NEEDS TO KNOW WHAT THE WATER DEPARTMENT IS GOING TO DO TO GET HER WATER. AFTER DISCUSSION IT WAS DECIEDED SHE WILL HAVE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LINES FROM THE PRESENT PLACE OF THE METERS. SHE MAY HAVE TO GET SOME EASEMENTS.

FAITH PARTON WAS PRESENT.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S
