

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DATE: NOVEMBER 3, 1998

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON NOV. 3, 1998, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER, AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN EUGENE REYNOLDS AND GARY HIGH, ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH, RECORDER PAT CARLTON. ALDERMAN SAM JONES AND ALDERWOMAN VICKIE WERE ABSENT.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF OCTOBER'S MEETING MINUTES. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. BESIDE THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS, A BILL FOR INSURANCE ON THE FIRE STATION, (RENEW AS IS) AND A BILL FOR MUNICIPAL LEAGUE INSURANCE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE TENTATIVE GENERAL REVENUE BUDGET. EACH ALDERMAN RECEIVED A COPY TO CHECK OVER. WE WILL VOTE ON IT NEXT MONTH.

NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. ECHO SAYERS WAS QUESTIONING THE TOWNS REGULATIONS ON DOGS RUNNING LOOSE. SHE WAS TOLD WE HAVE NO ORDINANCE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE WATER DEPARTMENTS 1999 BUDGET. AFTER DISCUSSION OF THE BUDGET ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BUDGET. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE COUNCIL HAS BEEN CRITICIZED FOR NOT CALLING TWO PEOPLE ABOUT A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING IN OCT. THE RECORDER HAD SAID SHE WOULD CALL THEM AT A MEETING SOME TIME AGE. ONE OF THE WOMEN DOES NOT LIVE IN THE TOWN LIMITS AND THE OTHER ONE HAS NOT ATTENDED A MEETING FOR OVER A YEAR. THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR SAID THE RECORDER IS RELIEVED OF THE RESPONSIBILITY TO CALL BECAUSE OF NON-INTEREST. THE MEETINGS WILL BE ANNOUNCED ON THE LOCAL RADIO STATION.

ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
