

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: AUG. 3, 1999

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON AUG. 3, 1999, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT, ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS. ELECTRICAL ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.





PUT \$2,500.00 OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND INTO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FUND.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF DELEGATION. KEVIN AND SHELLY ATCHLEY WAS PRESENT TO TALK ABOUT GUN CONTROL. THEY WERE TOLD THAT OAK GROVE DOES NOT HAVE AN ORDINANCE FOR ONE. THEY WOULD LIKE TO SEE ONE PUT INTO EFFECT. THEY ARE HAVING TROUBLE WITH GUNS BEING DISCHARGED IN AND ABOUT THEIR YARD. MAYOR MORGAN TOLD THEM SHE WOULD HAVE TO DO SOME STUDY AND RESEARCH ON THE MATTER.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
