

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE; JUNE 1,1999

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JUNE 1,1999, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, EUGENE REYNOLDS AND GARY HIGH. ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH . VICKIE ALLEN WAS LATE. RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES WERE READ. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECONIZATION OF DELEGATION. RON HIGH WAS PRESENT TO PRESENT A PROPOSED WATER ADDITION TO PROPERTY NORTH OF TOWN. WANTS THE WATER DEPARTMENT TO PAY ALL FITTINGS, HALF OF COST TO BORE UNDER ROAD. TERRY HUTCHISON WAS PRESENT AND HAD A WRITTEN BID FROM STATE LINE FENCING AND A ORAL BID FROM RALPH SMITH ON THE BALL FIELD FENCING. HE WAS TOLD TO GET ANOTHER BID AND IF STATE LINE IS THE LOWEST GO WITH THEM.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. BESIDE THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS, A BILL FOR WORKERS COMP. AND FIREFIGHTERS INCOME PROTECTION PLAN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

PAT CASHED THE WATER DEPARTMENTS CD IN AT BERRYVILLE AND BOUGHT ONE FROM GREEN FOREST. GREEN FOREST OFFERED THE MOST INTEREST.

GET INSURANCE ON THE NEW VAN. STEVE ALLEN SAYS THE VAN NEEDS SOME WORK DONE ON IT. THE WATER USERS AGREEMENT AND SYSTEM POLICIES NEED SOME UPDATING. WILL UPDATE AND PRESENT TO COUNCIL AT NEXT MEETING. RODNEY SAYS THE WEED EATER IS NOT IN WORKING CONDITION. IT'S AT LEAST FOUR YEARS OLD. TELL RODNEY TO HAVE SOMEONE LOOK AT IT AND IF IT IS WORTH FIXING, HAVE IT FIXED, IF NOT USE YOUR OWN DISCRETION AND BUY A NEW ONE. TAKE \$700.00 OUT OF GENENERAL ACCOUNT AND PUT IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT ACCOUNT.

THE COUNCIL AGREED TO PAY UP TO \$1500.00 ON RON HIGHS WATER LINES AND PUT IN THE FIRE HYDRANTS.

ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S.
