

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE; NOVEMBER 2, 1999

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON NOVEMBER 2, 1999, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN, PRESIDING OFFICER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN EUGENE REYNOLDS AND SAM JONES. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH. RECORDER PAT CARLTON. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH WAS ABSENT AND ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN WAS LATE.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF THE OCTOBER MINUTES. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL. THE COUNCIL INITIALED EACH BILL. BESIDE THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS WAS A BILL FOR STREET PAVING, AND A BILL FOR MUNICIPAL LEAGUE INSURANCE. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

SECRETARY PAT CARLTON GAVE THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR A REPORT OF THE BALANCES OF EACH ACCOUNT.

THE MAYOR GAVE HER REPORT: SHE IS STILL WORKING ON A GRANT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, THE BALL SEASON IS OVER AND IS WELL PLEASED WITH THE RESPONSE OF TEAMS, CROWDS AND HELPERS. STILL DON'T HAVE ANYONE INTERESTED IN TEARING THE OLD CANNING FACTORY BUILDING DOWN.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
