

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: AUG. 1, 2000

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING AUG. 1, 2000, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS, ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

OF HEALTH, INS. FOR WATER PUMP, HUGHES SUPPLY AND LEWIS EPLEY WERE PRESENTED. AFTER THE BILLS WERE CHECKED THEY WERE INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.




