

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: FEBURARY 1, 2000

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A RGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON FEBURARY 1, 2000, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUOUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN, ALDERMEN SAM JONES, EUGENE REYNOLDS AND GARY HIGH, RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. A BILL FOR INSURANCE ON THE PUMP HOUSE IS DUE. CALL AND SEE IF THE MUNICIPLE LEAGUE HAS A BETTER AND CHEAPER INS. IF NOT PAY THE BILL. THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS WERE PASSED TO THE COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR CHECKING AND INITIALED. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S, OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

EUGENE REYNOLDS RESIGNED AS SECRETARY FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. CITY SECRETARY PAT CARLTON TOOK BACK THE JOB. ALDERMAN SAM JONES WANTED IT TO BE PUT IN THE MINUTES THAT HE DID NOT WANT ANY MORE GRIPING ABOUT THE PRESENT SECRETARY HANDLES THE JOB. *how*

MAYOR MORGAN GAVE HER REPORT AND DISCUSSION WITH THE COUNCIL. THE RADIOS THAT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT HOPED TO PURCHASE FROM HOLIDAY ISLAND HAD BEEN SOLD ELSEWHERE BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT CONTACTED THEM. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT HAS PERMISSION TO CHECK ON THREE RADIOS THAT HUNTSVILLE HAS FOR SALE AND CAN PURCHASE THEM IF THEY ARE OKAY. WE GOT A CHECK FROM THE CABLE CO. THE FERGUSON BUILDING THAT HOUSES THE FIRE TRUCKS NEEDS SOME SIGNS THAT WILL ALERT VEHICLES THAT NO PARKING IS ALLOWED IN FRONT OF A FIRE BUILDING. SEE ABOUT GETTING A ATTIC FAN FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. *We did not get the grant we put in for. Will try next time. insert*
