

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

DATE: JUNE 6, 2000

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JUNE 6, 2000, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. 

AND THE REGULAR MONTHLY BILLS WERE PRESENTED. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.



THE AIR CONDITIONER HAS QUIT OPERATING. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO BUY A NEW ONE. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVORE SAY I, FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME, NONE. GARY HIGH WAS ASKED TO BUY THE AIR CONDITIONER, AS NEAR LIKE THE OLD ONE AS POSSIBLE. GARY WILL ALSO CALL RID-A-PEST TO SEE ABOUT HAVING THE FIRE HOUSE AND OFFICES SPRAYED FOR INSECTS.

ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
