TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
JULY 2, 2002

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JULY 2, 2002, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS, ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN WAS LATE.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF JUNE'S MEETING MINUTES. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? NONE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ORDER NEW CHAIRS AND TABLE, THE COUNCIL LOOKED OVER A CATALOG AND DECIDED ON A SET. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME, NONE.

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL DISCUSSED RENOVATION ON THE CHURCH THAT HAS BEEN GIVEN TO THE TOWN AND THAT WILL HOUSE THE OFFICES. PAT CARLTON CALLED LARRY CALLEN, JEFF DAVIS AND TOMMY SNOW. NEVER COULD GET A HOLD OF LARRY CALLEN, JEFF DAVIS COULDN'T DO THE WORK FOR A FEW WEEKS, TOMMY SNOW COULD GET TO IT SOONER SO HE GOT THE JOB OF ELECTRICAL WORK.
