

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 1, 2003

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING, APRIL 1, 2003, IN THE TOWN HALL. MAYOR MORGAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS, ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN, RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR A SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.


THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF DELEGATION. MR. AND MRS. GARY GRAY, ASKING WHAT WAS GOING TO BE ON THE LOT OF THE N.E. CORNER AT THE STOP LIGHT. SAM BARR, OWNER OF THE LOT, SAID THAT NOTHING WAS PLANNED AT THE PRESENT TIME BUT NO BAR. BONNIE WOOD AND RITA WALKER TALKED ABOUT UNSIGHTLY PROPERTIES NEAR THEM. LEAH MORGAN ASKING IF ANYTHING CAN BE DONE ABOUT LARGE TRUCKS USING JAKE BRAKES IN THE TOWN LIMITS. ECHO SAYERS AND SUZANNE NELSON WITH NO PARTICULAR REASON.
