

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 4, 2003

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING, NOV. 2, 2003, IN THE TOWN HALL. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN, ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF OCTOBER'S MINUTES. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? NONE. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. BILLS OTHER THAN THE USUAL BILLS WERE FROM JOURNAGAN CONST. CO., MUNICIPAL LEAGUES COMP. INS. AND AD&D INS. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

SECRETARY PAT CARLTON PRESENTED THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE TOWN. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BUDGET, ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. SHE NEXT PRESENTED THE WATER DEPT. BUDGET. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BUDGET. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY SAME. NONE.



THE WORK THAT NEEDS TO BE DONE ON THE BUILDINGS WERE DISCUSSED. THE FIREMEN WILL DONATE THEIR TIME TO DO THE WORK IF THE TOWN WILL PAY FOR THE SUPPLIES. THE BUILDINGS NEED TO BE SPRAYED FOR TERMITES AND FIRE STATION #2 NEEDS WORK DONE INSIDE THE OFFICE. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT, ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

INSURANCES FOR ALL PROPERTIES ARE DUE. THE COUNCIL LOOKED OVER EACH ONE AND SUGGESTED GIVING THE TOWN HALL TO SHELTER INS. AND INCREASING THE OFFICE FURNITURE IN THE TOWN HALL TO \$10,000.00 AND THE RADIO EQUIPMENT TO \$10,000.00. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO DO THIS, ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
