

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 7, 2003

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING, OCTOBER 7, 2003, IN THE TOWN HALL. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERMEN EUGENE REYNOLDS, GARY HIGH AND SAM JONES, ALDERWOMEN PAT HIGH AND VICKIE ALLEN AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF SEPT. MEETING MINUTES. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? ONE OMISSION. CR 624 WAS ALSO CHIPPED. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.


THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALIED BY THE COUNCIL. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

SECRETARY PAT CARLTON TALKED TO THE COUNCIL ABOUT CONSIDERING THE RAISING OF THE WATER BILLS. WE HAVE BEEN ADVISED BY FHA TO RAISE SMALL AMOUNTS EACH YEAR , RATHER THAN A LARGE INCREASE EVERY SEVERAL YEARS. ALTHOUGH OUR SYSTEM HAS DONE VERY GOOD, OUR EQUIPMENT IS 10 YEARS OLD AND WE MAY HAVE SOME EXTRA COSTS. WE MAY ALSO NEED TO INCREASE METER SETTINGS AND INSPECTIONS. JERRY KOPKE WILL COME AND TALK TO US AND ADVISE US ON WHAT TO DO.

MAYOR MORGAN READ ORDINANCE # 64-2003, IN FULL. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO PLACE IT ON ITS FIRST READING. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL VOTED AYE: SAM JONES, PAT HIGH, VICKIE ALLEN, EUGENE REYNOLDS AND GARY HIGH. MAYOR MORGAN READ ORDINANCE # 63-2003, PASSAGE OF MILLAGE ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I, FIVE I'S, OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NO OPPOSITION, THUS INACTING ORDINANCE # 63-2003. THE MAYOR THEN TALKED TO THE COUNCIL ABOUT WORK ON THE ROOF THAT IS LEAKING. GARY HIGH WILL CHECK ON IT AND REPAIR IF IT CAN BE REPAIRED.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
