

OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 6, 2004

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET ON JANUARY 6, 2004 , IN THE TOWN HALL FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, GARY HIGH AND EUGENE REYNOLDS, ALDERWOMN PAT HIGH AND RECORDER PAT CARLTON.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF DECEMBERS MINUTES. AFTER THE MINUTES WERE READ MAYOR MORGAN ASK FOR OMISSIONS OR CORRECTIONS. NONE. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ, ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I.FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL DISCUSSED GETTING SOME MORE CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS FOR THE NEXT YEAR. IT WAS AGREED TO GET 10 MORE. FRANK ALLEN WANTS TO KNOW IF THE GENERAL FUND CAN PAY FOR A MATCHING GRANT IF THE FIRE DEPT. GETS THE GRANT AND THE FIRE DEPT. WILL REIMBURSE WHEN IT COMES IN. IT WAS AGREED THAT IT WILL THE COUNCIL, MAYOR AND RECORDER FILLED OUT THE FINANCIAL REPORTS. DO YOU WANT THE SIGNS FOR "NO JAKE BRAKES" ORDERED? ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ORDER THEM. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. ALDERWOMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO GIVE EMPLOYEES AND WORKERS A 3% RAISE, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. DO WE WANT TO JOIN THE ONE CALL SYSTEM? ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION WE JOIN. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE

PAT CARLTON READ A LETTER ABOUT DISABILITIES ACT. SHE CALLED JERRY HONEY AND TOLD HIM THAT WE ARE NOT COMPLETE WITH ACCOMADATIONS BUT WE ARE MAKING ADJUSTMENTS AND WILL MAKE ACCOMADATIONS IN THE FUTURE. HE ADVISED US TO ERECT SIGHS SAYING WE ARE NOT HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN, ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
