TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
NOVEMBER 2, 2004

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR. MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING NOV. 2, 2004 IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. 
