TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 2, 2005

THE OAK GROVE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR., MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING AUGUST 2, 2005, IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH, ALDERMEN SAM JONES AND EUGENE REYNOLDS. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN AND ALDERMAN GARY HIGH WAS LATE.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF JULY MINUTES. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.


MAYOR MORGAN READ RESOLUTION #66-2005 INTITLED ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADOPT THE RESOLUTION. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. MAYOR MORGAN READ RESOLUTION #67-2005, CONCERNING HOME LAND SECURITY. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADOPT THE RESOLUTION. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. TWO BIDS FOR ROOFING THE TOWN HALL WAS PRESENTED. TIM JONES ROOFING AND A-1 ROOFING. COST IS ABOUT THE SAME ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS AND TO US TIM JONES FOR THE NEW ROOF. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FOUR I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN CALLED AFTER LAST MONTHS MEETING AND TOLD THE MAYOR SHE DIDN'T THINK THE FIRE DEPARTMENT NEEDED ALL THE O.B. KITS THAT WAS ORDERED AND SHE CANCELLED THE CLOTHING ORDER ALSO THREE C.P.R. BOARDS WERE RETURNED. SINCE SHE WAS RE-IMBURSED FOR THESE ORDERS SHE WANTS TO PAY BACK THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN INCREMENTS OF \$231.12 OVER THE NEXT THREE MONTHS UNTIL THE TOTAL OF \$1617.74 IS PAID. ALDERMAN GARY HIGH MADE A MOTION TO LET VICKIE DO THIS. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. THREE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VICKIE ALLEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
