THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR. MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING, OCTOBER 3, 2006 IN THE TOWN HALL. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEAN MORGAN AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. 
THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF MINUTES. THE REGULAR SEPT. 5 MINUTES WERE READ. ANY CORRECTIONS OR OMISSIONS? ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT. ALDERMAN JOSH PEDEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE. THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF SEPT. 18 WAS READ. ALDERWOMAN PAT HIGH MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AS READ. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. GARY MARSHALL HAD A BILL FOR \$450.00 FOR REMOVAL OF TREE AND CLEAN UP. ALDERMAN JOSH PEDEN MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS, ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
