TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
SEPT. 4, 2007

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, AR. MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING, SEPT. 4, 2007, IN THE TOWN HALL. MAYOR JEAN MORGAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED. ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT; ALDERMEN SAM JONES, EUGENE REYNOLDS, GARY HIGH AND JOSH PEDEN. NEW ALDERWOMAN VERONICA GRAY WAS SWORN IN.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF AUG. 7<sup>TH</sup> MEETING MINUTES. ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALDERMAN SAM JONES SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED. ALDERMAN SAM JONES MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS, ALDERMAN JOSH PEDEN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE RECOGNITION OF DELEGATION. A GROUP OF CITIZENS THAT LIVE ON CR 4351 WAS PRESENT. JUDGE RICHARD WILLIAMS WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS WORK ON CR 4351. THE ROAD IS A CITY ROAD. HE SAID HE WOULD CONTINUE A LONG-STANDING ARRANGMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND OAK GROVE. HE SAID THE COUNTY WILL MAKE IMPROVEMENTS IF THE CITY PAYS THE COST OF MATERIALS. MAYOR MORGAN SAID THE CITY CAN COVER THE COST AND THAT SHE THOUGHT JUDGE WILLIAMS PROPOSAL WAS FAIR. JUDGE WILLIAMS ALSO AGREED TO SEND GRADERS FOR A QUICK FIX. ALSO PRESENT WAS ROAD FORMAN, JAMES KELLY. HE GAVE COST OF ROCK AND CULVERTS.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE SEMI-ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT. THE STATEMENT WAS POSTED AT FIVE PLACES. THE AUDIT WAS PRESENTED.

ALDERMAN JOSH PEDEN MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALDERWOMAN VERONICA GRAY SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR SAY I. FIVE I'S. OPPOSED BY THE SAME. NONE.
